White Wines (125ml available)

Domaine St. Felix – Sauvignon, Vermentino (France) 13%

A Sauvignon Blanc and Vermentino blend from vineyards facing the town of Narbonne and the sea. Plentiful sunshine imbues the wine with lots of fruit, crunchy gooseberry from the Sauvignon and a broader more floral note from the Vermentino. A good all-rounder that will work well for light suppers, fish and salads.

Chaval Blanco Bodegas Nodus – Moscatel, Chardonnay (Spain) 12%

Chaval is the local Valencia name for a 'youngster' and the Chaval Blanco is the most fun and carefree of the whites from this great Finca. An organic Chardonnay Moscatel blend with bright floral soft fruit, hints of crisp apple and some ripe pear notes.

Saint-Peyre - Picpoul (France) 13%

Classic Picpoul - steely dry - but no tartness, more a crisp minerality that underlies the gentle hard white fruit. A tad floral too an apple blossom note - but this is bright driven and pure.

Delle Venezie Cantina Valdadige – Pinot Grigio (Italy) 12%

Apple, pear, spice and just a hint of something herbal. Good weight on the palate, richer, with ripe pear and peach, then some delicate spice on the finish.

Trocken Weingut Braunewell - Riesling (Germany) 12.5%

A dry, thirst quenching German Reisling. On the palate this is an explosion of intense citrus (lime, lemon & mandarin), coupled with floral notes and underpinned by a clean, mineral line. The finish is pure, moreish and juicy. Perfect for a summers day!

Domaine de Valensac - Sauvignon Blanc (France) 13%

Beautiful intense yellow colour with golden highlights. A velvety nose, with great aromatic complexity : Yellow fleshed stone fruits (Peach, Apricot), exotic fruits

(Pineapple, Passionfruit) and notes of grilled almonds. Fresh and frank attack in the mouth, good density and good length.

Rose Wines (125ml available)

Domaine St. Felix Rose – Grenache, Cinsault (France) 12.5%

A wonderfully dry, pale Rosé from the Languedoc-Roussillon. Made with two key grapes popular in Provence. It has a more citrus than red berry appeal, with oranges and dried orange peel at its heart and a peachy note.

Monteray Zinfandel Blush (USA) 10.5%

A most delicious wine, found to be a lively mix of watermelon and cherry with a delectable sweetness.

Primi Sol - Pinot Grigio Blush (Italy) 12%

An elegant & fragrant Pinot Grigio Blush, delicately aromatic and deliciously crisp on the palate.

MIP* (Made in Provence) - Cotes de Provence (France) 12.5%

Red fruits, hawthorn, pink grapefruit, touch floral. Nice richness in the mouth, good acid push, succulent stone fruits, citrus, redcurrant and cherry.

Domaine St. Felix – Merlot, Cabernet Sauv (France) 12.5%

From the coolish slopes near the large Etang de Thau & a stone's throw from the Med comes this crisp Merlot Cabernet blend, with a touch of Carignan for spice. Light & easy drinking.

MonFil – Garnacha, Syrah (Spain) 13.5%

A joyous nose of dark cherry, damson and raspberry, all backed by a lively pepperness. Smooth and supple and not in any way heavy (which is something lesser Garnachas can lean towards).

Salento Cantine De Falco - Primitivo (Italy) 13%

Bright and perky this has a fine zippy line that makes it not only food friendly but very moreish. Cherry skin and cooked damson and delightful drop from the sunny heel of Italy.

Cater Rim - Pinot Noir (New Zealand) 13%

Aromas of red cherry, rhubarb, mocha and delicate spice. Supple and sleek on the palate with fragrant red fruits and a return of gentle spice.

Sparkling Wine

Famiglia Botter - Prosecco (Italy) 11%

Lovely citrus and stone fruit aroma. On the palate it's crisp and refreshing with typical white peach and apricot flavours accompanied by hints of pear.

Famiglia Botter – Rose Prosecco (Italy) 11%

Light rose colour. Elegant and intense bouquet. Dry, soft and well-balanced on the palate; round and full bodied structure. Perfect as an aperitif.

IL Follo Cuvee Rose – Prosecco, Cab Sauv (Italy) 11.5%

Delicately pink sparkling wine from the Prosecco region, blended with 15% Cabernet Sauvignon making for a very attractive and quaffable aperitif.

Domaine Des Hauts Perra - Cremant de Loire (France) 12.5%

From a small family-run Domaine in the heart of Chenin Blanc territory, (Coteaux du Layon) this is a beautifully crafted Crémant de Loire. Traditionally made (bottle-fermented) sparkling wine which is vinified from a large proportion of Chenin Blanc, with some Chardonnay and Cabernet Franc - all grown on a mix of schist, clay, and quartz.

Baron Albert - Champagne (France) 12%

Bright, light and very fresh, this is an easy drinking 'aperitif' champagne with a very good finish. The Universelle cuvée comes from 7 different villages in the Marne Valley and has a rare blend - heavily dominated by Pinot Meunier (65%) with 30% Chardonnay and 5% Pinot Noir. The Baron family then age this for nearly 4 years in the cellar before release.
